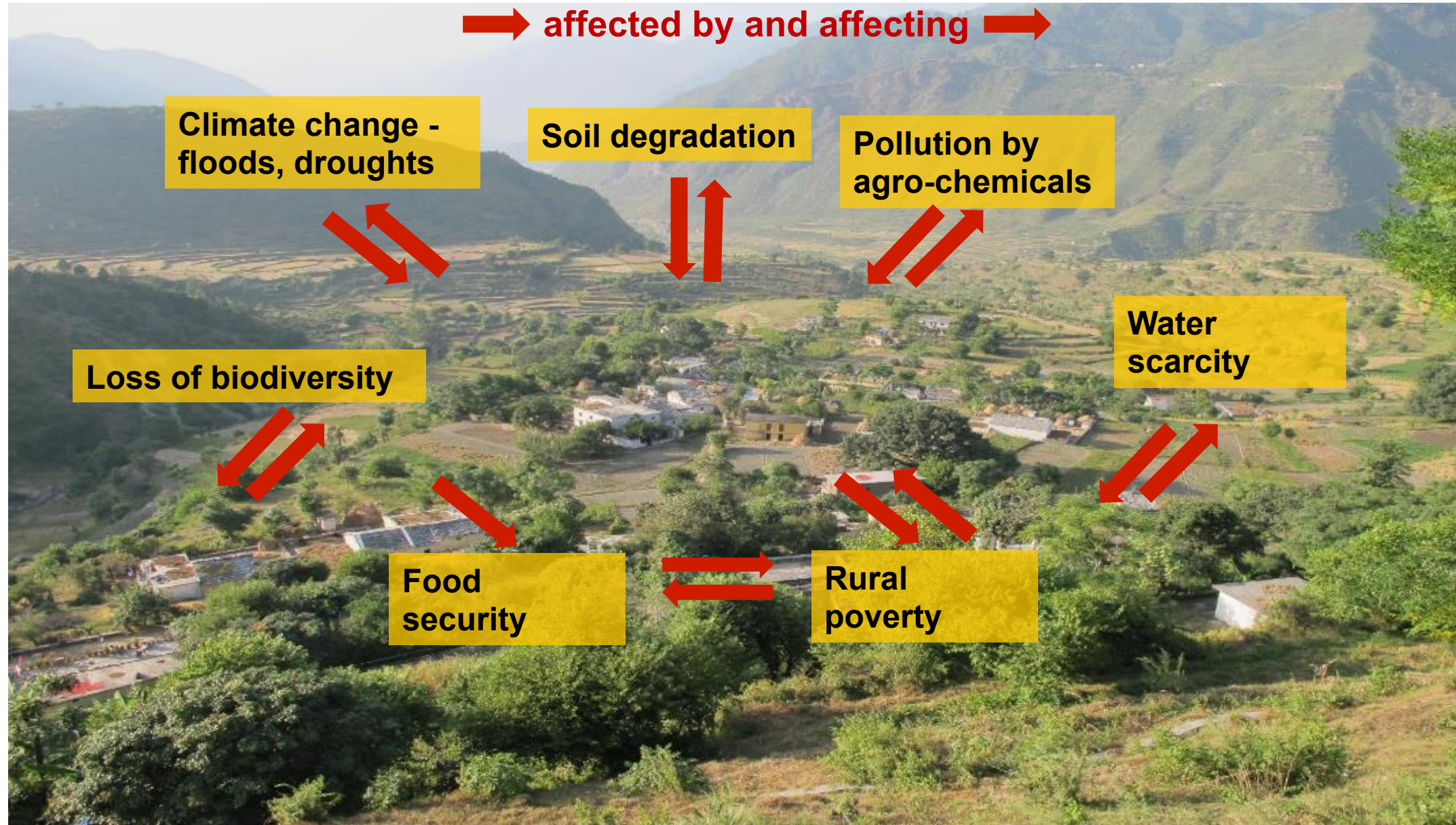

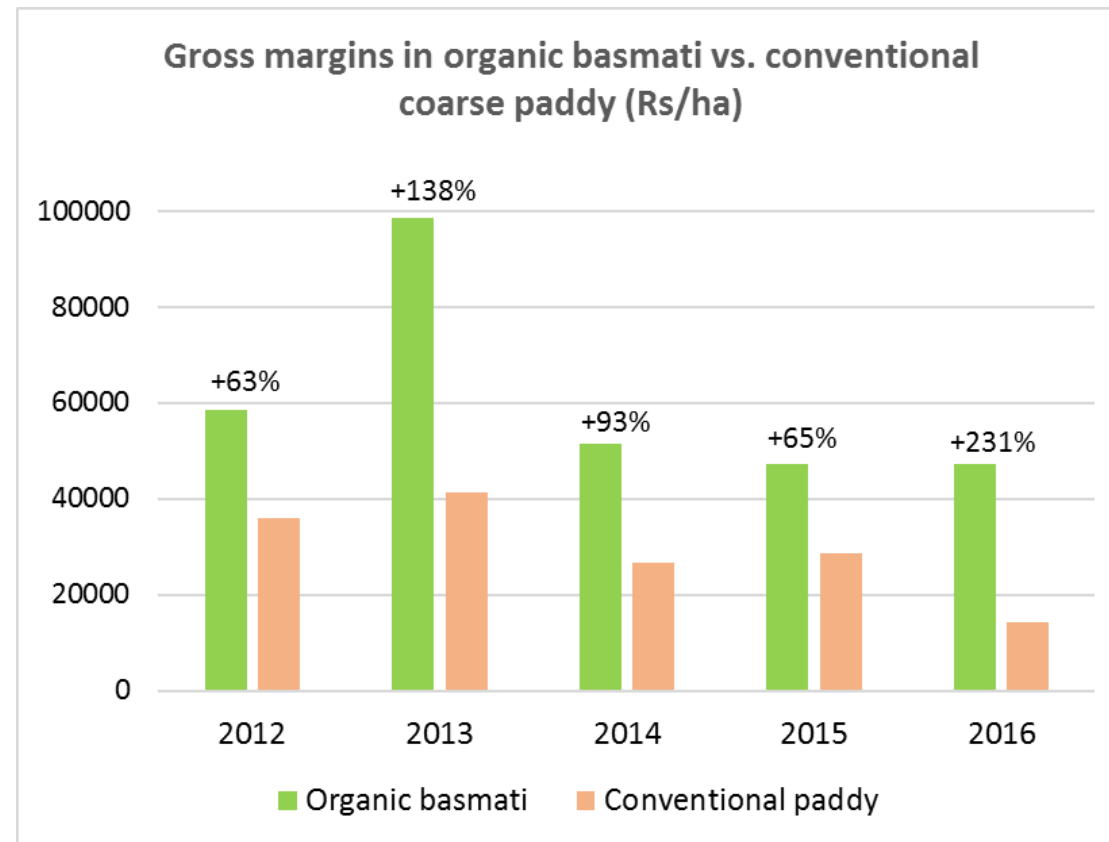


Rice farming has a key role with regard to global challenges

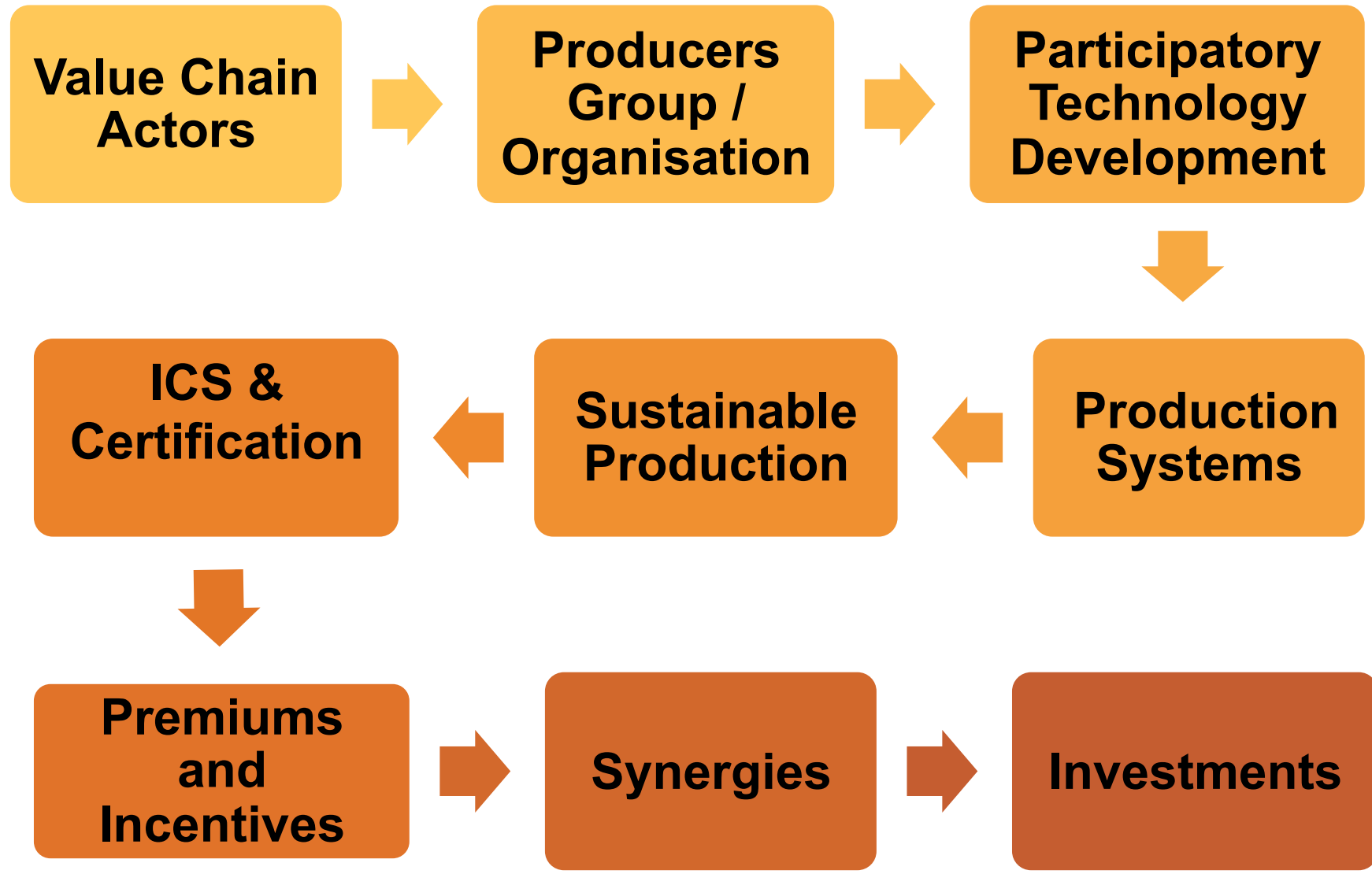


Sustainable rice production must:
